## Germaine's Luau:



Is located on west side of the island and is limited to around 200 hundred people per night. It has a family type atmosphere where you will sit close to the stage on picnic tables to enjoy an all you can eat buffet and show. There is only one package and the sooner you make your reservations the better your seating will be.

## Paradise Cove:

Is also located on the West side of the island near Ko'Olina which offers some of the best views of the sunset on the island of Oahu and makes for great group/family photos. Paradise Cove is more expensive than Germaine's but there are a lot of things to do.

Get there early (gates open at 5) as there are activities for the family: Hawaiian games, lei making, temporary Polynesian tattoos, and guided outrigger canoe rides in the cove. Small performances take place before the main show/dinner. Shower of Flowers, Hukilua, Royal Court Procession, and Imu Ceremony.



There are three different packages that are offered and seating locations vary accordingly with price. I personally recommend the middle package. Hawaiian Luau Buffet: 2 drink tickets, buffet service, and seating for this package is on the wings.

**Adults \$80 Juniors \$70, Children \$60**

Orchid Luau Buffet Package: Mai Tai and Flower lei greeting, 3 drink tickets, buffet service, center seating.

**Adults \$107 Juniors \$104, Children \$82**

Deluxe Luau Package: Mai Tai and flower lei greeting, 4 drink tickets, Deluxe Seating and Table Service, Souvenir Arrival Photograph, and Souvenir gift from Paradise Cove.

**Adults \$137 Juniors \$124, Children \$112**
