

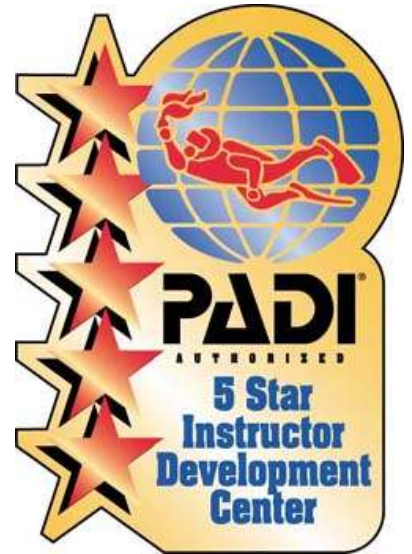
# Scuba Diving (No Experience Necessary)

Hawaii scuba diving has it all, clear shallow reefs for the beginner scuba diver or fantastic wreck diving for the more adventurous divers. You have come to the right place to take in a wide variety of diving. I use to manage **Aaron's Dive Shop**, which is located a few minutes from the house in Kailua.



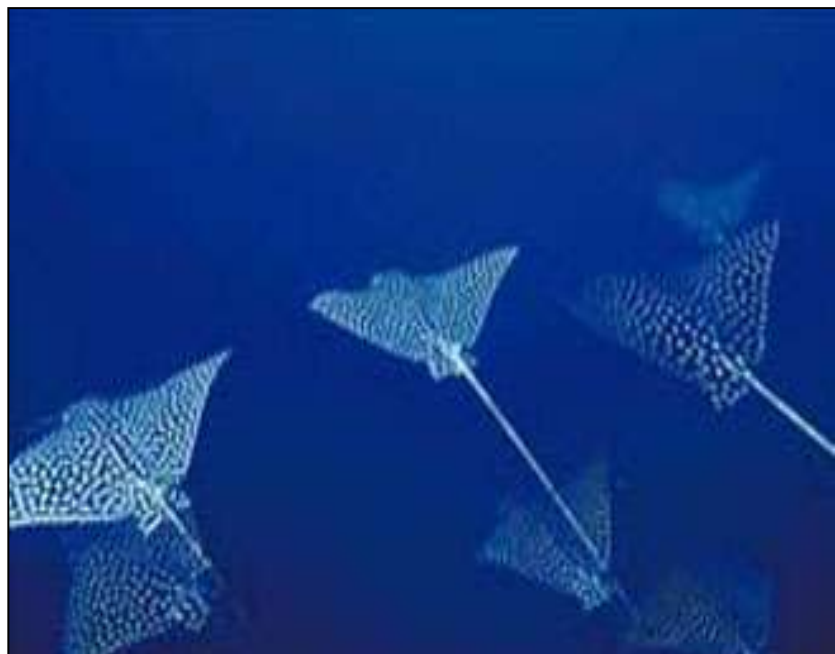
Aaron's Dive Shop is not only the closest dive shop to the house it has the highest **PADI** rating and has been in business for over 30 years. Whether you want to learn how to dive or become a dive master or instructor Aaron's is the place to go. They take out small groups of 6-8 people so you will have plenty of attention and won't be on a boat with 30 other people.

## **Introductory Dive**

Scuba diving is a very safe and relaxing activity when done together with trained professionals. Anyone from 10 years onward in normal health can participate in the PADI Discover Scuba Diving Program and experience the thrill of being underwater. You will start by meeting with your instructor who will guide you step by step. After the theory lesson you will have the basic knowledge about pressure, equipment and the underwater environment. Then you will practice in shallow water one on one with the instructor while breathing underwater and practicing a few simple skills. When comfortable being underwater you are then ready for your first scuba dive.

Together with your instructor, you will swim along the beautiful reefs, observing the colorful corals and fishes. During the dive the instructor will remain with you at all times and you will remain at a shallow depth. If there are experienced divers in the group you can all go on a dive together. Cost is \$125 per person for instruction, gear and 2 Boat Dives.



**The Introductory dive** is a great chance for anyone to try scuba diving and see why millions of people are scuba diving today. If you like this experience, you can enroll in the PADI Open Water Course and get an international scuba diving license in as little as 3 days.

## **Padi Open Water Dive Course**

Complete an entire entry-level certification course in just three days. Become a certified PADI Open Water Diver, allowing you to explore exotic reefs throughout the world. ½ day classroom, 1 pool dive, 4 boat dives.

### **Part 1.... The classroom (1/2 Day)**

Develop the knowledge of scuba diving. We feature the latest audio-visual media presentations to avoid long, boring lectures. Class schedules are flexible to your needs. By flexible, we mean, you let us know when you are available and we schedule your classes to fit your needs.

### **Part 2.... Confined water training (1/2 Day)**

Skill training is conducted in a stress free, relaxing swimming pool. Here you will find out just how easy it is to learn the water skills of a scuba diver.

### **Part 3.... Open water (4 Dives, 2 each morning)**

The final goal. In the ocean you do four actual scuba dives, spending a few minutes on each dive performing the skills you learned in the pool with your instructor. After the skills portion, you will spend the rest of the dive swimming with

schools of tropical fish, looking at colorful corals, and perhaps, even see an endangered sea turtle. Cost of a private Open Water Course is \$450 which includes all materials, rental gear, pool dive, and 4 Boat Dives.
